Thank you for choosing us for your pet's neuter. It's natural that you are going to have questions before your pet's surgery. Here are answers to the most common questions:

- The neuter will happen through a small incision near the back end.
- For dogs,we use absorbable sutures, so you won't see the stitches and you don't have to come back to have any stitches removed
- For cats, the incision is left with a small opening to drain.
- Chances are, other than the hair we have to shave, you won't even notice the incision
- After surgery, we use cold laser therapy on the surgery site to reduce any pain and swelling and to promote healing.
- Your pet can go home the same day. We'll set up a discharge time when you bring him in.
- When he goes home, he needs to avoid getting the surgery site wet. But, the rest of his activity can be normal.
- We do neuters Monday through Fridays.* We ask that you take away their food by 9 pm the night before surgery, but they can have water. Do not feed them breakfast in the morning, but continue to offer water.
- We can combine this surgery with other procedures that your pet might need like fixing hernias, removing dewclaws (dogs) or declawing (cats), tacking the stomach, or fixing problems with nostrils, eyelids or soft palates

*We can also set up special drop off or pickup days to accommodate your work schedule.

Preparing for your Pet's Surgery

To advanced pain management:

Pain can slow the healing process. We use a holistic approach to minimize pain, including

- nerve blocks (like your dentist uses)
- Pain medication before and during surgery
- Cold laser therapy after surgery. This special radiofrequency of light helps reduce swelling and promotes healing after surgery.
- Pain medication after surgery. Your pet will go home with a short course of pain meds to keep them comfortable at home.

And don't forget about the extra touches. Being

away from home can be stressful for your pet; we know that. Let us take care of your pet in recovery with:

- A recovery cove with a warmed bed and blankets
- A complimentary nail trim and ear cleaning while they are waking up
- After they are up and moving around, we give them a tasty treat back in their comfy condos.
